Professor Chen Weiming has long been engaged in research on the regional history of South China and the history of Hong Kong and Macao. He has developed distinctive research strengths in the urban history of Macao, the history of social life, transport geography in South China, the history and culture of ethnic minority groups, and the history of maritime merchants from Guangdong and Fujian. His research combines rigorous examination of historical sources, regional analysis and clearly defined research questions. It is of significant academic value for deepening the study of South China's history and culture, as well as the history of Hong Kong and Macao.
